### Kin of labourer who died in Kuwait seeks to retrieve body

Berhampur: The family of a migrant worker from Khojapalli in Ganjam district's Khallikote block, who alleged palli in Ganjam district's Khallikote block, who alleged yided in Kuwait 12 days ago, has requested the district administration to make arrangements to bring back his body. The decoased, Harsh Samal (26), had been working in a construction company in Kuwait since 2014. He had returned to the village in November 2016 and left for Kuwait again in January 2017, this time through a different, Bhubaneswarbased agency, his father Ramesh said. "The agency collect Res 90,000 from him towards different expenses, including light ticket and visa," Ramesh added.

On October 13, a person who did not identify himself called Samal's family to inform them about his death. He did not reveal the cause of death either: "We have requested the administration to bring back the body," Ramesh said.

"We have already submit da report to the collector on the subject," said district labour officer Siah Narayam Sahoo. The deceased its survived by his aged parents, wife Geeta and two children.

Collector (Ganjam) Vijay Amruta Kulange has also writen a letter to the labour commission seeking his help in bringing back the body of the labourer to his native village for the last rites.

Jharsuguda: The villagers of Hirma, Kumhari, Tareikela, Tumbekela and Luheranka-char under Hirma panchayatof the district on Tuesday staged a protest and boycotted a public hearing in Gariadihi village on the social impact assessment of hearing in Gariadhi village on the social impact assessment of a proposed 3200 MW thermal power plant being planned by Neyveli Lignite Corporation Li-mited (NLC) in the bortlering area of Jharsuguda and Sam-alpur.
