bench of Justices NV Ramana, Ashok Bhushan and Sanjiv Khanna said, "In the emergent In facts and circumstances, to curtail unlawful practices such as horse-trading, to avoid uncertainty and to effectuate smooth running of democracy by ensuring a stable government, we are of the con sidered opinion that it is necessary to pass certain interim order (for holding floor test) in this case."

The interim order worked itself out with Fadnavis's resignation paying the way for the Thackerayled Maha Vikas Aghadi to form the government. But the interesting part of the order is that the bench has kept the Sena-NCP-Congress petition pending to examine the validity of the governor's decision to recommend revocation of President's rule in the night, invite Fadnavis to form the government and administer oath within hours of the Aghadi declaring that the three parties had worked out a common minimum programme and would stake claim to form government

The bench asked the governor and Fadnavis to file their responses to the Sena-led petition in four weeks and ordered listing of the matter for detailed hearing after 12 weeks, by which time the Aghadi will be in power and will be carrying out governance in the name of the governor.

Will it maintain its vitriolic stand against the governor and demand scrutiny of his actions between 7pm and 8am on November 22-23 or withdraw the petition in order not to embarrass the governor and not create an incongruent situation of fighting against a constitutional office in whose name it car ries out the task of governance?

The SC said, "There is no gains aying that boundaries between jurisdiction of courts and parliamentary independence have been contested for a long time. However, there is a need and requirement for recognising institutional comity and separation of powers so as to tailor judicial interference in the democratic processes only as a last resort. This case pertains to one such situation, wherein this court is called upon to adjudicate and maintain democratic values and facilitate fostering of the citizen's right of good governance.'



Mumbai: Over a month after the state assembly resulted were declared, Maharshtra governor BS Koshyari has called for a special session of the legislative assembly on Wednesday, which will begin at 8am, to administer oath to the 288 newly elected MLAs.

On Tuesday, the governor appointed Kalidas Kolambkar, BJP MLA from Wadala, as the protem speaker. He is the senior-most MLA who has won the assembly elections for eight consecutive terms. Sources said with the Se na-Congress-NCP alliance staking claim to form the government late on Tuesday, it is likely a show of strength of their MLAs will be seen inside Vidhan Bhavan premises.

Kolambkar was appointed on the directions of the SC. The SC ordered afloor testfor the Devendra Fadnavis government, and asked the governor to appoint a pro tem speaker and ensure all elected members of the House are



sworn-in by 5pm on Wednesday. "Governor Bhagat Singh Koshyari has called a special session of the legislative assembly on Wednesday. The session would begin at 8am for the oath-taking ceremony of the 288 members," said the official. Congress MLAs Balasaheb Thorat and K C Padvi had also been shortlisted for the post.

"We are happy that the political crisis has come to an end. It was a month since we were elected but not sworn in. People from our constituencies were coming to us with their problems but we had no authority to take action. Now we can start working in our constituencies," said a first-time

MLAs to take oath today, pro tem speaker appointed Quelling Ajit rebellion may help senior Pawar rebuild credibility

Pune: "A wrestling coach teaches his disciples all tricks of the game but keeps that one trick to himself" — this was the top post on 'Fakta Sharad Pawar Saheb", the Facebook page of Pawar's followers, on Tuesday, soon after his nephew Aiit Pawar quit the Devendra Fadnavis government.

However, what the senior Pawar achieved by overseeing the downfall of the days-old government in Maharashtra is not just limited to establishing that he is the undisputed boss of NCP and that he has the ability to take on the Chanakyas of the saffron parties. His winning chess-like moves during the fluid political situation gave him the opportunity to reclaim his credibility.

Interestingly, it was a rebellion by him that dented his credibility early on in his political career when he became the CM of the state at the age of 38, and it is the quelling of the rebellion by his nephew which may help him regain that evasive "trust factor" that has been missing from his brand of politics. For many years now, Pawar has been dubbed the

"unpredictable politician". "When he says yes, he means no," his critics say.

Therefore, when Ajit took oath as deputy CM on November 23, the suspicion that he may have done so on the directives of his uncle lingered throughout the day. This despite the senior Pawar tweeting that assuming office was Ajit's personal decis ion.

Such has been the apprehen-

Congress leader told TOI that he had conveyed to the party high command his niggling doubt that Pawar would double-cross them. Congress had, therefore, taken time to come on board with NCP and Shiv Sena.

.In his five-decade-long political career, Pawar has switched parties in the quest for power and, when needed, even amended his standon issues

Pawar broke away from Congress in 1999 while questioning Sonia Gandhi's foreign origin. But he joined hands with the same party later in a post-poll alliance and even gave public speeches justifying how, according to Indian tradition, a daughter-in-law becomes part of the family, irre-

n 2018, the Karnataka elections saw BJP fall short by seven MLAs and led to a bid to rope in opposition legislators with BSYedivurappa being sworn in as CM only to resign. In both cases, the SC ordered a floor test under the protem speaker, and the two resigned instead of seeking the trust vote.

Coming just after the underpar performance in Maharashtra and Haryana and ahead of the tough Jharkhand match, questions will be asked about whether BJP was right in trusting Junior Pawar's claim that he had the numbers. Though Fadnavis said the plan was that of the state unit, the party brass are very much in the line of fire. The BJP may have underesti-

mated NCP patriarch Sharad Pa-

war, perhaps because the latter, who had in an ideology-agnostic manner, offered unconditional support to BJP in 2014, now did not comearound. He gave the clear impression that he was opposed to a deal with BJP after a bitterly-contested election where he and Fadnavis had targeted each other.

Internally, the leadership will argue it had to explore all means to avenge Sena's betrayal and to stop Maharashtra from falling into the hands of rivals. And that sitting on the sidelines, even when Ajit appeared as a partner, while ally-turned-foe Sena walked off with the trophy would have made BJP a

sight too.

Yet the tactics, though they failed, reflect the thinking of the BJP leadership to make a bold

push for power even when numbers are dicey. The tactics failed in Karnataka in the first instance but worked in the longer run. In Maharashtra, the large gap between BJP's 105 to the majority mark of 145 will, however, make a change in assembly numbers moredifficult

BJP sources say the party's initial plan was to accept the fallout of

the Sena's bickering and sit in the opposition. It felt the party would be the ultimate beneficiary as the three parties will run into inevitable difficulties in handling demands and conflicting interests in several regions of the state.

Before he quit as CM, Fadnavis said at a presser, "Ajit Pawar has submitted his resignation to me and now we don't have a majority,

We are not into horse-trading. After this presser I shall meet the governor and submit my resigna tion too. Fadnavis said Ajit had cited personal reasons for his inability to continue with BJP. Ajit, he said, had extended support unconditionally and only he would be able to answer why he withdrew

Fadnavis spoke of the sequence of events that led to BJP forming an alliance with NCP's Ajit Pawar, from Sena's first press er where it claimed "other options were open" to its demand for the CM's post for 2.5 years. "The mandate was clearly for the Mahayuti but BJP secured the largest number of seats, becoming the single largest party. Its strike rate of 70% was much better than Sena's 42% It was clear the people's mandate was for BJP" he said.
