

300 held for opposing eviction drive

Talcher, Oct 29: Exploration and transportation from 10 mines of Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd (MCL) were disrupted Tuesday after 300 agitators were detained for offering resistance to an eviction drive at Bhaluagada to facilitate expansion of Hingula mines. The MCL authorities, backed by police, were evicting agitators who were opposing the expansion. The agitators were emboldened after Talcher MLA Braja Kishore Pradhan (BJD) reached the spot and offered his moral support to the sit-in. In the evening, the police detained over 300 villagers when Pradhan courted arrest along with others. The agitators were detained at Hingula colmines project of H. Later, the MCL authori-

Balaram mines reopening sought
ANGUL: Solada villagers staged a sit-in at the Collector's office here Monday, demanding reopening of Balaram coal mines, closed since October 12 due to a dispute over transportation of coal.
Additional District Magistrate discussed with a five-member team of the agitating villagers Monday and urged them to call off the strike and promised to concede their demands within two days. But the agitators remained adamant and insisted that they would continue the sit-in till reopening of the mines. The agitators were continuing their sit-in till Tuesday evening, it was learnt.
Maa Kalapat Truck Owners' Association vice-president Gadadhara Sahu, who is leading the agitation, said the strike would be withdrawn only after their demand was conceded.

ties resumed the evictions. Soon after Pradhan's arrival in the 10 MCL colmines reached the spot leading to disruption of coal production. Consequently work at the mines at Hingula, Balaram, Jagannath, Lingaraj, Bhubaneswar, Bharatpur, Ananta and Kanha were affected causing disruption of transportation to the National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC). Talcher Thermal Power Station (TPPS) and other units outside Odisha. The incident occurred after MCL authorities reached Bhaluagada to carry out evictions. The police used tear gas and water cannons to disperse the agitators. The drive was being supervised by Angul SP Jagannath Meena in the presence of Talcher Sub-Collector Prakash Chandra Nayak, SDO Hemant Kumar Pandya, a magistrate, several police I/Cs and 12 platoons of force. Earlier, the authorities urged the villagers to vacate their land to which the latter offered resistance. The authorities, however, went ahead with bulldozing the housing structures. On being informed, Talcher MLA Pradhan reached the spot and urged the agitators to halt the evictions until a tentative rehab arrangement is made. Police, however, refused to listen and detained the villagers along with their vehicles. Meanwhile, angered by evictions, a few locals ransacked the Dera guest house and staged an impromptu sit-in at Handlichang Square and Colliery police station. M.L.A Pradhan continued the information to the land losers. Superintendent of Police Jagannath Meena claimed that no one was arrested or detained so far. Arrested Colliery Nayak denied that M.L.A Pradhan was arrested, insisting "It was the legislator who courted arrest." Hingula colmines project officer Ajay Singh said the evictions are going on over seven hectares near the mines had been evicted.

Angul, Oct 29: Secretary to Chief Minister, Transformation and Initiatives (GT), VK Pandey Tuesday paid a surprise visit to Angul district headquarters hospitals here to assess the status of the government healthcare facilities. Pandey, accompanied by the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) Director Shalini Prasad, Deputy Inspector General of police (DIG) Nrusingh Bhuji and District Collector Manoj Kumar Mohanty visited Tuberculosis and Gynaecology and Obstetrics department in the district headquarters hospitals (DHH) in the district. The officials interacted with the patients and enquired about the quality of treatment, the conduct of doctors and nurses towards the patients, disbursement of free medicines, food, sanitation and diagnostics facilities.

Notably Police October 9 busted a gambling den at Padmagiri in Malkangiri district and arrested seven persons in connection with the case. The police, acting on a tip-off about the illegal activity a police team led by superintendent of police (SP) Rishabh Kumar, carried out the raids on a house and apprehended the accused persons. Pandey advised the doctors and paramedics to work sincerely to provide treatment to the satisfaction of the patients. He also visited Deogarh District Headquarters Hospital to assess the functioning of the government healthcare facilities. He reviewed the status of the government healthcare facilities in the hospital. The team also interacted with the patients and their relatives at the hospital and inquired about the facilities. Later, the team visited Deogarh Model College.

Subsequently, in order to grab a pucca house under the PMAY she applied again by tampering with documents. She allegedly mentioned the name of her elder brother-in-law, Balaram Behera, as her husband and produced a photo that had Balaram beside her. Later she applied for a house under PMAY. Surprisingly she managed to become a beneficiary in 2019-20 by submitting fake papers and managed to get ₹2,00,000 as first instalment. Meanwhile, Debendra Sharma demanded a thorough inquiry and action against the beneficiary along with the government officials involved in the scam. When contacted, District Collector Samant Verma said he would order a probe into the incident.

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Two minor girls rescued from TN, Karn

Bhubaneswari, Oct 29: Two minor girls who were missing from a shelter home in Kalandi district since September have been rescued from Bangalore and Chennai. A 24-year-old man has been arrested for allegedly prompting the girls, aged around 15 years, to flee the shelter home run by an NGO here. On September 24, Kalandi Superintendent of Police B. Ganadhar said,

Police teams rescued one girl and arrested the accused, identified as Puran Chandra Chhatra, from Bangalore. Another girl was rescued near Chennai Sunday. All of them were brought here Tuesday, the SP said. The Police had launched an investigation after the girls, who belong to villages under Jataputa Police Station limits, went missing. When one girl was traced to the outskirts of Bangalore, the other was found near Chennai where they were engaged in a brick kiln and a tailoring unit respectively, police said. Accused Chhatra of Tentulikhuri under Jataputa area, was responsible for the whole episode and he assisted the two girls to escape with him, they said. The accused engaged one girl in the brick kiln near Bangalore where he is also working, and engaged the other girl in a tailoring unit at Tirupur near Chennai.
