MINUTES OF MEETING HELD WITH VILLAGE COMMITTEE OF
 JAMBUBAHALI VILLAGE AT BHARATPUR AREA ON 04.09.2013

A meeting with villager committee of Jambubahali village was held at Bharatpur Area on 04.09.2013 to discuss the problems of the villagers.

The General Manager, Bharatpur Area welcomed the members of the village committee and invited for discussion. The following points were discussed.

1. Villagers demanded uninterrupted Power supply to the village. It was assured to the villagers that uninterrupted power supply can not be guaranteed. However efforts will be made to avoid breakdown of power supply.
2. The consumption by the villagers should be realistic and excessive consumption to be checked. Village agreed to monitor misuse of power by the villagers.
3. To avoid fluctuation in voltage, OH line and jumpers will be checked.
4. Difference in current in two phases to be balanced.
5. The dispute in completing the diversion of road to JMB workshop and Hingula Area will be resolved with the co-operation of village committee.
6. The proposal of heightening of compound wall will be discussed in Area CSR committee meeting.
7. A Medical check up camp to be held in the village.
8. The cases of about 30 unemployed persons have been referred to RPDAC.
9. The work of diversion of Power line passing over pond will be taken up.
10. The proposal to provide water from South quarry will be examined.
11. Play ground to be leveled.
12. Anti larva treatment will be done JMB workshop to prevent mosquito breeding.
13. The proposal to provide water to school from Workshop will be examined.
14. For developing a play ground, suitable land to be identified by the villagers.
15. A shed to be constructed over the burial ground and stone pitching to be done around the village pond.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD WITH VILLAGE COMMITTEE of
RAKASH VILLAGE ON 21/05/2013 AT 6.00 PM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL
OF OFFICE OF GENERAL MANAGER, JAGANNATH AREA

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At the onset of the meeting, Staff Officer (L&R), Jagannath Area welcomed the village committee members of Village Rakas and Bharatpur Area officials.

The discussion was made on the point-wise agenda submitted by Rakas Village Committee. After threadbare discussion, the point-wise agenda was concluded as under:

1. Compensation payment of balance tenancy land of the village.
 - It was informed to the committee that award preparation is delayed due to delay in approval of rates by MCL Hq. GM, Jagannath Area assured the village committee that rates will be approved by 20th June and GM, Bharatpur Area assured that by 15th July, the prepared award will be read over to them in the village so that necessary correction if pointed out by the concerned tenant can be corrected before sending it for approval.
2. Resettlement site for displaced families of village Rakash
 - It was informed to the committee that the approach road to the earmarked plot at Boulpur village is through Forest land. GM, Bharatpur Area assured the village committee that necessary DGPS survey will be completed by August and he will meet with Collector, Angul, for early approval for this road. MCL will try to start development of earmarked plot after rainy season.
3. Employment of remaining land losers
 - a). Category "C" class land losers.
 - It was clarified to the Village Committee that no Category-C land losers of the village will be provided with employment.
 - b). Employment of Grandson's who have attained the age of 18 years as on cut-off-date
 - As per Orissa Govt. circular , it was decided that the employment benefit to Grandson's who attained the age of 18 Years as on Cut- off date will be eligible, where 2006 policy of Orissa Govt. is applicable. It was informed to the villagers that any alternative change by the higher quarter in that circular regarding providing employment benefit to Grand Son, it will be taken up.
 - c). Employment of Sri Basudev Bhukta , nominee of Sri Gokula Bhukta
 - It was informed that Cash compensation in lieu employment to Gokula Bhukta has been approved by MCL Hq.

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- d). Employment of nucleus family nominee on attaining the required age limit.
- Bharatpur Area officials informed that it will be done. Presently, 7 such cases are in process for providing employment.
- e). Early finalization of vetting cases
- (i) Sri Bholeswar Naik- It is informed that it is a cat-C case. Though it is vetted but Collector is not approving this case since Cat-C of village Rakash are not eligible. Village Committee informed that for this case, they will meet with Collector, Angul. However it was informed that the category of Bholeswar Naik will be upgraded to Category "A" by taking the land acquired under Padama Block. Action will be taken up accordingly when R & R benefit will be provided to the land oustee of village Rakash in Padma Block.
- (ii). Ku. Siba Garnaik- It is informed that her case been sent for approval of Collector, Angul after due vetting.
- (iii). Ku. Arpita Garnaik- Her case has been approved as Cash Compensation in lieu of employment. The family is insisting for employment. Case is under consideration at MCL Hq.
- f). Cash Compensation in lieu of employment of Sri Pramod Chandra Bhukta- MCL Hq has denied this case. GM, Jagannath Area assured to follow up this case.
4. Heavy blasting by Bharatpur OCP is creating problems to villagers
- GM, Bharatpur Area assured the committee that he will take care that control blasting is being done near to village.
5. Village Committee insisted for providing employment of left out cases
- Bharatpur Area officials informed the committee that they shall provide final list of left out cases for necessary action at their end.
6. Syntax Tank Staging & platform for Borewell shall be provided at the earliest.
- Bharatpur Area officials informed that already tender has been finalized. The work will be started very soon.
7. Steps to the Pond at village Rakash.
Project Officer, Jagannath OCP, informed that necessary action will be taken up for providing Step to the Pond before rainy season.

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General Manager, Jagannath Area & Bharatpur Area thanked the village committee for their co-operation in smooth operation of Jagannath OCP & Bharatpur OCP.
