Minutes of the meeting held in the Conference Hall of GM Office, Ib Valley Area on 21.1.12 with the Project Affected Persons of Chingiriguda village.

A meeting with the residents of Chingiriguda village (PAPs) was held in the Conference Hall of GM Office, Ib Valley Area on 21.1.12 at 11.30 AM, wherein 45 villagers and officials of Ib Valley Area were participated. The list of participants are enclosed as Annexure-1.

At the outset, the General Manager, Ib Valley Area welcomed the PAPs of Chingiriguda village and solicited their active support for handing physical possession of land and dwelling houses in Chingiriguda village to MCL as well as their resettlement.

The villagers raised the following grievances before the General Manager and requested for immediate redressal of the same.

- 1) Alternate site for resettlement near Sani Mandir area, Belpahar in place of Madhuban Nagar.

The villagers demanded for providing plots within Belpahar Municipality Area as they are already staying in the Municipal area. They accordingly suggested for providing land for resettlement near Sani Mandir, Belpahar, which is within the Municipal Area of Belpahar Municipality. The General Manager, Ib Valley Area informed the villagers that the location near the Sani Mandir preferred by them is a part of Goutam Dhara coal block and may acquire in future for mining purpose. Therefore, they were requested to opt for house plots in the rehabilitation site of MCL near Jahaja Padia (near TRL), where the project affected persons, eligible for 10 decimal of land, shall be provided 04 decimal of land due to shortage of sufficient space. For balance 06 decimal, the PAPs will be granted cash. The villagers informed that they will discuss the issue amongst them and intimate the outcome within 3 - 4 days.

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- 2) 100% land of village Chingiriguda should be acquired.

General Manager informed that since the balance land in Chingiriguda village may be required for expansion of Lajkura OCP in future, the request of the villagers may be considered favourably after obtaining approval from HQ.

- 3) Cut-off date for employment to be revised to 2010.

This has not been agreed to . However, it is informed that in the event of acquisition of balance land for expansion of Lajkura OCP, the cut-off date may be shifted to affected families only.

- 4) Fresh census of families and structures.

This has been agreed to. It has also been agreed for fresh measurement of house structures built on Govt Basti plots for which compensation has not yet been paid. But it has not been agreed upon he denied fresh measurement of house structures, which have been measured and the cases have been finally settled / payment of compensation has been made. However, the PAFs, who have extended their house structures during the period should make an application to the General Manager, for measurement of extended structure, if any, which will be considered on its merit.

- 5) All homestead lease holders must be treated at par with PAPs.

The matter will be examined and lease granted by the Government before acquisition of land by MCL will be considered on its merit.

- 6) Pending court cases to be decided out of court.

This has been deferred and will be discussed in the next meeting.

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7) All individual cases for employment to be heard in person/to decide in light of M.C.L. Policy.

This has been agreed to.

8) All Royati land acquired by MCL must be corrected and deleted from the Revenue record and should be recorded in the name of MCL.

This has been agreed to. For this necessary steps will be taken for mutation of MCL acquired land.

9) Provide employment to land less villagers through private contractors.

The villagers were advised to submit the list of such persons so that they can be considered for providing training for self development / self employment within the frame work of MCL's Policy.

The following decisions were also taken.

- (i) Next meeting with the village committee will be held on dt.20.02.2011.
- (ii) Re-measurement / measurement of left out house structures (item wise) over Basti Plots should be completed by Project authorities by 15th Feb. 2012.
- (iii) Family Genealogy will be updated on the basis of old records.

The meeting ended with thanks to Chair.

The SO(L&R), Ib Valley Area welcome to all the villagers present in the meeting and asked to start the meeting with the demand of the villagers.

The villagers raised their demand as under :-

1. Alternative site for resettlement near Sani Mandir area, Belpahar in place of Madhuban Nagar.
2. 100% land of village Chingriguda should be acquired.
3. Cut-off date for employment to be revised to 2010.
4. Fresh Census of families and structures.
5. All homestead lease holders must be treated at par with PAPs.
6. Pending court cases to be decided out of court.
7. All individual cases for employment to be heard in person/to decide in light of M.C.L. Policy.
8. All Royati land acquired by MCL must be corrected and deleted from the Revenue record and should be recorded in the name of MCL.
9. Provide employment to land less villagers through private contractors.
10. Re-measurement/measurement of left out house structures(item wise) over Basti Plots should be completed by Project authorities by 15th Feb,2012.

Reply of SO(L&R), Ib Valley Area as follows:-

1. The RPDAC in its meeting dated.23.01.2013 has decided the Madhuban Nagar will be Rehabilitation site for MCL.
2. Requisition has been made to Collector, Jharsuguda on dtd.31.03.2013 for acquisition and notification of balance land of village Chingriguda.
3. Cut-off date for balance land to be acquired will be shifted after notification.
4. Fresh census families will be made for the house structures which will not yet paid compensation. Other families will be considered as on cut-off date of payment of their house structure.
5. Defination of PAPs will be considered as per the Guidelines issued by Govt. of Odisha.
6. Settlement of court cases out of court is a policy matter.
7. Agreed on the matter of all individual cases for employment to be heard in person/to be decided in the light of MCL Policy.
8. Necessary steps will be taken for mutation of MCL's acquired land with consultation with Tahasildar, Lakhanpur.
9. List should be submitted by the villagers.
10. Measurement has been done and submitted to MCL HQ. for approval. The MCL HQ. returned the file with guidelines for assessment. The same is under preparation and will be sent to MCL HA. in 1st week of July,2013.
11. Updated family genealogy will be prepared on the basis of Old records.

At the outset, members of the village committee extended their hearty welcome to Sub-Collector, Jharsuguda and General Manager, Ib Valley Area with officials present in the meeting.

Staff Officer(L&R), Ib Valley Area also extended hearty welcome to all members and villagers, and appraised the house all details about the acquisition of land, payment of compensation and rehabilitation status. Sri Deepak Ranjan, Dy. Manager(Mining), SOCP spoke that the objective of the meeting is to sort out the constraints in early shifting of the Chingriguda village and steps to be taken thereof.

He requested all villagers to express their difficulties in shifting of the village so that the same could be solved as early as possible.

The villagers expressed their views as laid down here below :-

1) Dulamani Pradhan (President, Village Committee)

- (i) Due to delay in shifting of the PDF's for the last 18 yrs, the size of the families have expanded, the families have extended their house structures to accommodate their family needs. Hence a fresh family census may be carried out and re-settlement benefits to the extended family may be given.
- (ii) Balance land of the villagers to be acquired.
- (iii) R&R benefits to the landless / homesteadless families residing in the village.

- (iv) Payment of house structures on Govt. Basti plots of the villages.
 - (v) Payment of extended house structures constructed on tenancy land and also on lands of other tenants.
 - (vi) Extension of CBA Tribunal (Bench) to Jharsuguda District and finalization of court cases under CBA Act.
 - (vii) To provide Re-settlement site at Belpahar Municipality Area (Jahajpadia).
 - (viii) Consider employment for the land oustees, not considered earlier.
 - (ix) Repairing of School building damaged due to blasting.
- 2) Lalit Pradhan , Ex.Councilor, Chingriguda village.

- (i) After 20 years, the village is going to be shifted and the children are now grown up. MCL may take care of their employment.
- (ii) Jurabaga Re-settlement site may be selected for Re-settlement purpose.
- (iii) The village is affected due to mining activities, so they want immediate shifting from the village.

3) Khemasagar Kisan, Chingriguda village

Balance land of the villagers should be acquired.

4) Ramakanta Pradhan , Chingriguda village

Sani mandir site to be declared as Resettlement site.

5) Narendra Pradhan, Chingriguda village.

- (i) As on date, what are the Re-settlement benefits to be provided as per R&R Policy, may be communicated to the villagers.
- (ii) Till the shifting of the village, all facilities should be provided like drinking water, light, road etc.
- (iii) The houses are getting damaged due to blasting operation. The Project authority should go for controlled blasting to check the vibration and damage caused to houses due to blasting.

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- (iv) Madhuban Nagar is an accident and dust prone area. There is an U/G. mine beneath the said area and there is chance of it catching fire from below. The site will also be distant for the villagers who are posted at Lakhanpur Area.
- (v) Facilities to be provided to ~~the~~ to purchase the land of SC & ST.
- (vi) Extension of CBA Tribunal Bench to Jharsuguda and early finalization of Court cases pending at Tribunal.
- (vii) Joint listing of the persons opting for cash or plot may be done.
- (viii) Payment of compensation for house structures over Basti Plot should be made at the present market rate.

6) Akrura Pradhan, Ex.Sarpanch, Bijadera(Chingriguda)

- (i) The village should be shifted immediately. No delay should be done in this connection. Make all arrangements for shifting of the village.

7) Dilip Majhi, Bijadera(Chingriguda).


Walls of houses are broken due to affect of blasting.

8) Tikeswar Bag, Bijadera(Chingriguda).

Before shifting, arrangements with all facilities in the shifting site may be done.

9) Shanti Hati W/o.Late Jujesti Hati and Minaketan Pradhan, Chingriguda

Raised the issue of employment of their son and daughter respectively.

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To reply the points raised by the villagers, the General Manager of Ib Valley Area appraised the status as well as action initiated by MCL for shifting of Chingriguda village.

- (i) 4(1) notification of the balance land of 53.60 Ac. land is under process, 10% establishment cost has already been deposited with the Zone Officer, MCL Works, Brajrajnagar on dtd. 29.11.2013. The Sub-Collector, Jharsuguda who is also in-charge of Zone Officer, MCL Works, Brajrajnagar assured that 4(1) notification will be processed and forwarded to Higher authority very soon. Thus employment scope will be there for the eligible families after completion of 4(1) notification.
- (ii) As all the unemployed youth can not be given jobs in MCL, youth from the landless families residing in the village shall be provided self employment by imparting ITI training, Coal transportation jobs through Co-operative Society, Driving training etc. The left out youth from other families will also be given skill development training on the sponsorship by MCL. The entire cost of training etc. shall be borne by the MCL.
- (iii) Drinking water shall be provided to the village till their shifting. This year onwards the management as regards different problems being faced by the villagers, the Ib Valley Area will take care, not ~~the~~ Lakhanpur Area.
- (iv) In order to avoid the damage of structures or fear of blasting, it was suggested that the villagers should set up their mind for shifting to R&R site in addition to that due care shall be taken during blasting operation to avoid the danger of vibration. In other words, MCL will go for controlled blasting.

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(v) Madhuban Nagar will be designed as a model R&R site and all infrastructure facilities will be provided. Proposals are under finalization for expenditure of an approx. amount of Rs.7.00 Crores for the same. Dense afforestation to be done in the site, road dispatch to be minimum in future, water sprinkling shall be done effectively. Boundary wall and all other facilities as provided in MCL's colony shall be provided in the R&R site. As regards presence of U/G Mines, there is no apprehension of fire in the U/G mine, there shall not be any compromise on the safety aspects of the PAFs. This shifting will be from one municipal area to another municipal area.

(vi) For the purpose of the R&R benefits for Chingriguda village, the R&R Policy-1989 of Govt. of Orissa is applicable. In addition to that , MCL's R&R policy will be applicable. The details to be provided to PDFs of village Chingriguda is as under :-

(1) Homestead Plot or Cash Grant	: 10 decimal developed plot at Rehabilitation site or Rs.3.00 lakhs in lieu of Plot.
(2) House Building Assistance	: Rs. 2,24,000.00
(3) Maintenance Allowance	: Rs. 36,000.00 (@Rs.3000/-per month for 1 yr.)
(4) Assistance for Temporary shed	: Rs. 15,000.00
(5) Transportation Allowance	: <u>Rs. 3,000.00</u>
Total	: <u>Rs. 5,78,000.00</u>

In addition to above, incentive for early vacation and handing over home/homestead & agricultural land:-

- (1) Within 01 month period of shifting : Rs.1.00 lakh.
- (2) Within 02 months period of shifting : Rs.0.75 lakh.
- (3) Within 03 months period of shifting : Rs.0.50 lakh.

(vii) GM, Ib Valley Area assured that the list of the Project Displaced family shall be supplied to the villagers for their information.

- (viii) To hear grievances of the villagers, the next meeting shall be held on dtd.16.12.2013
- (ix) Representation to be given by the villagers for measurement of extended part of the house structures over their own land for enlargement of family size, but no compensation to be paid to the Pucca structures modified from Kutcha structures to new structures, structures made by the out siders, structures extended over house structures on other's tenancy land and Govt.land.
- (x) Fresh census of extended family after 1995 will be again discussed in the next meeting.
- (xi) Representation to be given by the villagers to District ^{Resettlement} Rehabilitation Officer for taking necessary action and to put up before RPDAC for one time disposal of the CBA dispute cases.
- (xii) General Manager, Ib Valley Area told clearly to the Villagers that only one R&R package to be paid to the Project Displaced family having house on other's tenancy land and objectionable Govt.land.
- (xiii) General Manager, Ib Valley Area informed that the house structure compensation over Basti plots and other govt.land have been calculated considering the value of the structure as on date of 4(1) notification and interest 9% and 15% calculated upto the year 2012 had been forwarded to MCL HQ. for consideration. The same was put up to Functional Directors meeting, but it has been informed by the MCL HQ. that, the interest should be calculated upto 31.03.1995 i.e. the last ^{date of} award of the village. The villagers protested the same and requested to the MCL Officials that present rate of the house should be paid to the villagers, as till ^{now} date no R&R site has been made available to them, now cost has ^{grown} up.


Lastly the Sub-Collector, Jharsuguda offered his views on the following points raised by the villagers.


- (i) Matter relating to CBA Dispute may be put up before RPDAC for quick disposal of the cases.
