The meeting was chaired by the D.T(P&P), MCL. After thorough discussion, the following deliberations were made:-

- 1) The proposal for acquisition of the Basti area of village Patharmunda & Kaniha will be put up before the MCL Board on 5<sup>th</sup> Feb'2014 for getting approval. After getting the approval from the MCL Board the proposal will be sent to the Ministry of Coal, New Delhi for getting approval for acquisition. This will take at least three months i.e. till May'2014.

After getting the approval from the Ministry the actual process of acquisition of remaining land in village Patharmunda & Kaniha will start as per the Land Act in vogue.


- 2) The family survey work being carried out in village Kaniha will continue.
- 3) The measurement work in village Patharmunda will commence from 1<sup>st</sup> Feb'2014 in respect of the acquisition made under Kaniha phase-I & phase-II.
- 4) The representatives of the villagers of village Patharmunda & Kaniha told that the eligible persons of whole the village will take employment at one time. In this respect it was informed by the management that for this resolution in writing from all the villagers will be needed. In absence of such resolution in writing, the management can not stop giving employment to any eligible person who opts for employment.
- 5) The representatives of the villagers demanded that the acquired land should not be used for any commercial purpose. The management requested them to be always positive to allow the use of the acquired land in the interest of the company as well as the villagers.

The meeting was ended with vote of thanks to the chair.

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING REGARDING R&R AND LAND ACQUISITION ISSUES OF KANSAMUNDA VILLAGE UNDER KANIHA OCP HELD ON DT.24.07.2013 IN THE OFFICE OF THE CMD, MCL, BURLA.**

CMD, MCL was in the Chair.

At the outset CMD, MCL welcomed all the officials and representatives of village Kansamunda present in the meeting and requested Sri Gurukrishna Pradhan and others to extend their co-operation so that the mining activities in Kaniha OCP can be done smoothly.

Then as desired by the CMD, MCL, GM, Kaniha Area informed the house about the present status of job rehabilitation and land acquisition in respect of village Kansamunda. After prolonged and detail deliberation on the issues raised by the representative of village Kansamunda, the following decision were taken.

1. 4(1) Notification of balance land including basti area of Kansamunda under Gopalji Project will be expedited by Compiling the information/data required by MOC, Govt. of India at the earliest.
2. Alternate arrangement will be made by extending pipeline to discharge the mine water through natural drain (nalah) beyond Kansamunda village.
3. Crop compensation in respect of the plots over which mine water is being discharged is to be ascertained by the Agricultural Dept. of Govt. of Odisha.
4. Staff officer (L/R&R), Kaniha Area will apprise on last Friday of every month regarding the progress of the Land acquisition, structure measurement and other job rehabilitation issues of village Kansamunda in the monthly meeting held in the site office of the Kaniha OCP.

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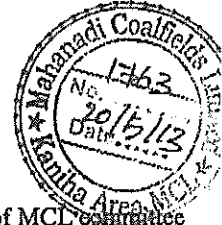

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD WITH THE VILLAGERS OF JARADA ON  
DT.08/05/2013 AT THE SITE OFFICE, KANIHA OCP**

A meeting with the Village committee members of Jarada village was held on dt.08.05.2013 at about 6.00 PM at site office of Kaniha OCP to discuss about different issues of Jarada village. The following members were present in the meeting.

At the outset of meeting General Manager, Kaniha Area welcomed all present in the meeting. The following are the proceedings of the meeting.

- The village committee of Jarada wanted to know about the present status of getting the resettlement site at Takua for Jarada.
  - GM, Kaniha Area told that the matter is subjudice. The counter affidavit by MCL management has already been submitted before the honorable High court.
- The committee members wanted to know about the status of payment to be done in respect of left out structures.
  - GM, Kaniha Area told that FD of MCL has already forwarded the matter for decision of MCL board.
- The committee enquired what is the status of the proposed Bus facility to be provided to the MCL employees of Jarada.
  - GM, Kaniha Area told that the tendering process for this was already completed but the documents given by L1 party are not correct. So there will be a retendering for this.
- The committee asked about the supply of drinking water to their village.
  - GM, Kaniha Area told that already 16,000 ltrs. are supplying drinking water to Jarada on behalf of NTPC. In addition to this MCL will provide 16,000ltrs of drinking water within Monday. He requested the committee to nominate two members who will verify the supply of drinking water to different parts of the village and sign in the record. The committee nominated the names of Sri Dandadhar Sahoo & Sri Brundaban Sahoo.
- The Committee wanted to know about the status of digging of ponds in the village.
  - GM, Kaniha Area told that it is under process and Tahasildar; Kaniha will have a meeting with the committee to select 2 or 3 sites in the village to dig ponds.
- The committee wanted to know the status of medical facilities proposed to be given to people of Jarada at NTPC Hospital.
  - GM, Kaniha Area told that he has already talked with competent authority of NTPC in this regard and this facility will be started with immediate effect.
- The committee wanted for availability of Ambulance.
  - GM, Kaniha Area told that Departmental Ambulance has already been stationed at site office Kaniha under the administrative control of Sri. N.K.Tiwari, W.O (T) for use in emergency.

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**MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD WITH THE COAL COMMITTEE OF VILLAGE  
JARADA, ON DTD. 09.02.2013.**  
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A meeting was held with the members of the coal committee of village Jarada at 11.00AM, in the conference hall of Jagannath Area, to discuss about the issues/problems in respect of village Jarada.

The Chairman-cum-Managing Director of MCL was on the chair.

The meeting was also attended by the following dignitaries, officials and villagers.

At the outset, General Manager, Kaniha Area welcomed all dignitaries, MCL officials, village president and the villagers present in the meeting and informed that the meeting was arranged as per the request of the villagers. Then the problems related to the village Jarada was discussed point wise, as mentioned below.

**a). Resettlement Site**

Initiating the discussion, Sri R.C. Roul coal committee member told that the villagers of Jarada are informed that MCL is making arrangement of one Resettlement site in village Takua. He complained that the progress of work of alienation is not satisfactory. As advised by CMD, MCL, GM, Kaniha Area informed the house about the chronological activities done for the acquisition of the same land in village Takua and also informed the obstruction made by the villagers of Takua on dtd. 24.01.2013 when the Tahasildar, Kaniha, Range Officer, Kaniha and the MCL officials were jointly verifying the Govt. Land to be acquired.

Sri R.C. Roul told the CMD, MCL to take up the matter to a higher level so that the land is made available by the Govt. of Odisha for a resettlement site of MCL. Honible MLA told that the Collector, Angul should be requested to conduct a meeting with the villagers of Takua on this issue. Sri R.C. Roul & Sri K.C. Pradhan told the CMD, MCL to give written and time bound programme for providing the resettlement site so that the villagers can have trust on MCL.

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The CMD, MCL made it clear that nothing can be given in writing, since the villagers of Takua are resisting the process. He also informed that once the land is made available to MCL, every step will be taken to prepare the resettlement site at the earliest. He assured that the villagers would reside in their own village till a resettlement site is handed over to them and if required the working of the mine will be done at a distance of 300 Mtrs. from the village on safety and pollution ground.

The DT(P&P), MCL told that the land in Takua should be acquired in due procedure so that there would exist good relation between the villagers of Takua & Jarada.

Sri Saroj Sahoo told that all the villagers would reside in one resettlement site and MCL should not compel the Jarada villagers to vacate their houses accepting the resettlement package of MCL.

Sri Pandav Sahoo told that no one of village Jarada should be given cash compensation in lieu of plots till the resettlement site is handed over to the villagers. The CMD, MCL told that MCL can not stop any one from doing so, because cash compensation in lieu of plots are given to the willing PAFs only.

Then CMD, MCL appealed the villagers not to go for any obstruction since MCL is already on the job for a resettlement site.

**b). Enhancement of Rate of Land acquired in 1<sup>st</sup> phase & compensation already paid.**

The villagers demanded for enhancement of rate of land at par with the rate revised by the Tribunal court for the land of village Kansamunda. The CMD, MCL told that once the compensation is paid & settled, no further enhancement is possible.

**c). Balance cases of employment.**

The villagers demanded for taking necessary steps so that the pending cases of employment are cleared at an early. The same was agreed to.

**d). Provision of drinking water.**

Sri R.C.Roul told that MCL should make the provision of drinking water in village Jarada till they vacate their village. The CMD, MCL proposed the same to be executed through the Panchayat with the fund of MCL. Since the villagers did not agree upon this proposal, it was agreed to get the above work done by MCL directly.

**e). Provision of bus for the conveyance of the employees residing in village Jarada.**

The CMD, MCL told the General Manager, Kaniha Area to take necessary steps so that bus facility can be extended to the employees of MCL residing in village Jarada. DT(P&P) agreed that the consent of the employees to avail that facility is to be taken beforehand.

**f). Employment for the grand son cases.**

Regarding the grand son cases it was informed that the grand son cases can be considered after receipt of a Govt. circular/order in this respect.

**g). Engagement of non-eligible nominees as security guards.**

Sri Kailash Chandra Pradhan demanded MCL to engage the non-eligible nominees as security guards. It was informed that the security guards are engaged by the security agencies under DGR guidelines. Hence no comments can be given on this issue.

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After long discussion over the issues the following decisions were taken.

1. Process of alienation of land for a resettlement site at Takua is to be expedited.
2. Mine working will be made at a distance of 300 Mts. from the village, till a resettlement site is handed over to the villagers.
3. The structures existing in area acquired in 2<sup>nd</sup> phase is to be started after arrangement of civil engineers.
4. Bus facility as a means of conveyance to be started with due consent of the employees interested for it.
5. Provision of drinking water shall be made in the village by drilling bore wells by MCL.

Finally, the CMD, MCL appealed the villagers to co-operate MCL in conducting all the mining activities of Kaniha OCP including palli sabha required for forest diversion, in the interest of the nation and the meeting came to an end followed by vote of thanks.
